1. Eli Whitney - invented interchangeable parts (cotton gin)
2. Francis Scott Key - wrote the star-spangled Banner
3. War of 1812 (America's Enemy) p 78 - U.S. fought the British in the War of 1812
4. Thomas Jefferson (p. 75) - Thomas Jefferson approved the Louisiana Purchase
5. Louisiana Purchase (p. 76) - Doubled the size of the U.S. / cost us 15 million dollars
6. Louisiana Purchase Square Mileage - We bought 828,000 square miles
7. Impressment - Forced military service of American citizens
8. War Hawks - congressmen who wanted to go to war during the war of 1812.
9. Battle of Thames - William Henry Harrison won + Tecumseh was killed
10. The Burning of Washington - took place during the war of 1812
11. Fort McHenry - Francis Scott Key wrote the star spangled Banner after this battle
12. Battle of New Orleans (p. 78) - huge victory for the Americans at the end of the war
13. \$15 million (p. 76) - was the cost of the Louisiana Territory
14. Robert Fulton (p. 80) - Invented the steamboat
15. Lewis and Clark (p. 76-77) - explored the Louisiana Territory for President Thomas Jefferson
16. Sequoyah - helped write the Native American alphabet
17. The Treaty of Ghent (p. 78) - Ended the War of 1812
18. William Henry Harrison - killed Tecumseh at the Battle of Thames
19. John Marshall (p. 76) - was the 4th chief Justice of the Supreme Court
20. Native Americans - lived on most of the acquired land prior to the Louisiana Purchase.
21. Monroe Doctrine (p. 79) - was introduced by President James Monroe
22. Embargo Act of 1807 (p. 78) - was started by the Monroe - Pickney Affair
